







GREEN HOMES: LOS ANGELES GREEN AFFORDABLE HOUSING PROGRAM

Take advantage of FREE guidance and resources to provide a healthier and more sustainable environment for residents, while also saving money on energy, water, and waste!

The Green Affordable Housing Program (GAHP) provides resources to help multi-family building owners/managers and residents reduce utility costs and improve occupant health while reducing greenhouse gas emissions in lower-income communities in the Eastern San Fernando Valley and San Pedro/Wilmington.

Multi-family properties could receive:

-  Resident engagement sessions in English and Spanish covering sustainability practices to help reduce utility costs and increase occupant health
-  Enrollment assistance with LADWP programs and rebates
-  Building assessments and guidance through a menu of efficiency & electrification options to facilitate high-performance building retrofits
-  EV charging stations installed at low-to-no-cost to future-proof the property
-  Heat pump technologies (space and/or water heating) installed at low-to-no-cost to explore building electrification strategies
-  Access to innovative green building pilot projects to increase energy efficiency
